- Completed a minimum of 60 transferable credit hours with a GPA of 2.0 or above
- Provide documentation of current Florida Nursing License of license in the state where student will conduct practicum activities
- Evidence of current CPR (American Heart Association) certification
- Complete a bachelor's application

Classes may be taken online or as hybrid courses. Classes must be taken in order by term but students do not have to be full time.
