Students who declare a Music Teacher Education transfer major are exempt from the IDS 1107 requirement.

Note for Advisors About FSCJ's Course Numbering Schema for Applied Music Courses:

FSCJ's course numbering schema for Applied Music: Classic Keyboard differs from that listed in the Statewide Course Numbering System (SCNS). Please see the concordance table below:

MVK X111: Classic Instruction--Freshman--Keyboard	MVKA 1111: Classic Piano I
MVK X112: Classic Instruction--Freshman--Keyboard	MVKB 1111: Classic Piano II
MVK X121: Classic Instruction--Sophomore--Keyboard	MVKA 2121: Classic Piano III
MVK X122: Classic Instruction--Sophomore--Keyboard	MVKB 2121: Classic Piano IV

The College is aware of the need to align the numbering schema for its applied music courses with those in SCNS and has a long-term plan to do so. Students should work with an advisor for assistance with contacting their intended transfer university (e.g., FAMU, FAU, FGCU, FSU, UCF, UF, UNF, USF, UWF) about satisfying prerequisites for the Music Teacher Education program and clarifying any discrepancies with course numbering.

Important for You to Know:

- This academic roadmap does not include developmental education courses in reading, writing, and/or mathematics that you may be required to take. In addition, it does not include MAT 1033: Intermediate Algebra, which, for many students, is a prerequisite course for MAC 1105. Please consult with an advisor for individual assistance.
- Students who enter a Florida College System institution in academic year 2014-2015 (and thereafter) must demonstrate **competency in a foreign language** (Florida Statute 1007.25). Students can demonstrate the required competency in one of three ways:
 - Earning two high school credits in the same foreign language;
 - Completing a sequence of two college-credit courses in a single foreign language;
 - Achieving the required level on a language proficiency exam from the American Council for the Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL).

College-level foreign language courses count as A.A. electives and are applied toward your twenty-four hours of required A.A. electives.

- Students who enter a Florida College System institution in academic year 2018-2019 (and thereafter) must demonstrate **competency in civic literacy** (Florida Statute 1007.25). Students can demonstrate the required competency in one of two ways:
 - Completing one of two civic literacy courses (either AMH 2020 or POS 2041) with a grade of C or higher;
 - Achieving the standard score on a state-approved assessment.
