FSCJ Partners with U.S. Navy for Apprenticeship Program

FSCJ was awarded the U.S. Navy contract in partnership with Fleet Readiness Center Southeast (FRCSE) for an apprenticeship program. The program offers apprentices up to four years of tuition-free education and training in one of eight skilled trades while they also earn an hourly wage and benefits as an FRCSE employee at Naval Air Station (NAS) Jacksonville.

Following acceptance into the program, apprentices are employed by FRCSE while completing courses to earn credit toward FSCJ's Engineering Technology Support Specialist Technical Certificate (T.C.)

Board Highlights

Review the highlights of the August 8, 2023, meeting of the FSCJ District Board of Trustees:

- The District Board of Trustees approved revisions to Board Rule 6Hx7-9.9 Adjunct Instructor Work Load and Instructional Responsibilities.
- The District Board of Trustees approved a 3.5% salary increase, with a minimum of \$1,000, for all eligible full-time non-instructional employees.
- The District Board of Trustees approved the revised 2023-24 Salary Index as part of the Pay Plan.
- The District Board of Trustees approved an extension to the 2023 Winter Break, adjusting the start date to December 20, 2023.
- The District Board of Trustees approved the change in the College's 403(b) Retirement Plan from the current five-year plan to an eight-year plan.
- The District Board of Trustees approved fee changes for the following courses effective Fall Term 2023: Aviation Maintenance Technology General I, II, III, IV.
- The District Board of Trustees approved the revised Academic Calendar for 2023-24.
- The District Board of Trustees approved the activation of the Entrepreneurship in Interior Design Advanced Technical Certificate program embedded within the Associate in Science degree program in Business Administration, effective in the Fall 2023 Term.
