Re: Hurricane Matthew and Its Possible Impact on our FSCJ Students

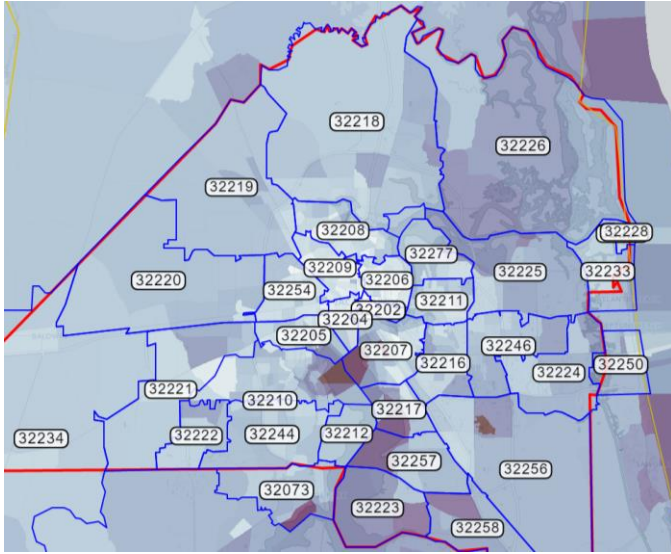

It is estimated that more than 1.5 million people in Florida were under evacuation orders and more than one million customers lost power in the aftermath of Hurricane Matthew, which bared down and devastated Haiti and made its way North. In Jacksonville, the storm caused multiple zones, especially those in the coastal areas, to be under mandatory evacuation. This means that many of our FSCJ students in zones A-C were forced to vacate from their homes to find safety. FSCJ serves over 50,000 students, many living on the coast. This was a devastating natural disaster that left destruction in its path. As a college community, we want to make sure that we are there for our students and provide them with the help they may need to get back on the road to academic success.

The following is an estimated number of our students who may have been impacted by this storm, specifically highlighting the areas that may have been included in the mandatory evacuation zones. This list is not all inclusive of all possible areas that were in the storm's path (St. Augustine, etc...). I took into account the zip codes that were most affected, as per the weather patterns and coastal areas, and compared them to the number of actively enrolled students that we have living in those zip codes. The list of enrolled students was obtained with the help from Lauren Zanders and Ryan Schnippert of our Onboarding Department.

We know that there are students who have/will reach out to instructors, advisors, and staff with questions about relief or help for students who may have been impacted, displaced, or are in financial woes. We understand that having to evacuate one's home can place significant physical, emotional, and financial stress on our students. Please let us know of any students who you may have direct knowledge of that may be in need of help in the aftermath of Matthew. We will do our best to help steer them towards the appropriate community and/or institutional resources. Thank you for your continued service to our students.
