Before You Apply

- Your Alien Registration number (if applicable)

Get Your Parents Support If You're a Dependent

- All information is private.
- It doesn't matter how much money your parents earn.
- Signing doesn't make your parents responsible for your education costs.

To Apply

- Apply at **fafsa.gov**.
- Use FSCJ's school code: 001484.
 If you do not include our school code, we will not receive your FAFSA.
- Answer all applicable questions
- Sign and submit your application

After You Apply

- Check your processing status online any time after applying
- Review your Student Aid Report (SAR)
 when it's emailed to you (within 3-5 days)
- Check the status of your financial aid in myFSCJ.
