**What are the Requirements for Adult Education
ESOL Classes?**

- Must be 16 years of age or older(underage documentation required)
- Bring your Florida driver's license or other valid identification document
- Provide immigration/citizenship documents:
 - U.S. Citizens (including Puerto Ricans): U.S. Passport or naturalization document
 - Permanent Residents: Valid permanent resident card, temporary card, or passport stamped "Temporary I-551
 - I-94 or USCIS approval letter stamped: Asylum Granted, Paroled, or Refugee
 - Valid Visa or passport stamp
 - I-797C - USCIS approval letter showing application to apply or change status
 - Employment authorization card

All Visa types except B1/B2 Tourist Visas and F-1 International Student Visas are accepted.

Please check with an advisor about scheduling procedures for CASAS pre-testing once you have received your FSCJ User ID.
