

The Career Certificate (C.C.) in Facials Specialty provides a theoretical and practical hands-on approach to learning all aspects of facial specialty including facial treatments, sanitation/safety methods and procedures, facial makeup/application, hair removal, and operation of skin care machines.

This program is for those students seeking an esthetics certificate. A certificate of completion enables students to qualify for a state esthetics license. Day and evening classes start each fall, spring and summer based on interest.

Total Program Credit Hours

Students considering a Career Certificate in **Facials Specialty** should be aware that the program requires **220** contact/clock hours that must be completed and documented. Students should also understand and accept the attendance requirements prior to enrolling in this Career Certificate program. This Career Certificate Facials Specialty clock-hour program is **not** eligible for financial aid.

Important for You to Know

Facials Specialty registration applicants must be at least 16 years of age. Applicants must complete 220 school hours in a Florida facial specialty program. Applicants should submit the initial HIV/AIDS course completion certificate received from their school. The HIV/AIDS course must have been completed within two years prior to submitting an application and must be at least four hours long. Applicants do not have to take the Florida cosmetology examination for this registration. A completed Certification of Eligibility Form from Section IV of form COSMO 1 must be submitted with application.
