Total Program Credit Hours

Students considering a Career Certificate in **Florida Law Enforcement** should be aware that the program requires **770** contact/clock hours that must be completed and documented. Students should also understand and accept the attendance requirements prior to enrolling in this Career Certificate program. This Florida Law Enforcement Academy clock-hour program is eligible for financial aid.

Important for You to Know

The day Basic Law Enforcement program is a full-time program. You will attend class Monday through Friday, 8 a.m.-5 p.m. It takes 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ months to complete the program. You are required to pass the

Criminal Justice Basic Abilities Test (CJBAT) for Law Enforcement Officers (LEO) prior to entry into the program. Information and appointments found here: <u>https://home.pearsonvue.com/fdle</u>. Upon completion of this program along with a passing score on the State Officer Certification Examination, students will obtain a Certificate of Law Enforcement valid throughout the State of Florida. Upon successful completion of the program, students may receive articulated College credit toward the Criminal Justice Technology (2239) (A.S.) degree. This is a basic certification, and additional training will be required by the hiring agency.

The Northeast Florida Criminal Justice Center is a certified training center through the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) at <u>fdle.state.fl.us</u>.
