ASN Nursing Requirements

Nursing R.N.

- 1. For new students, complete an online application to the College by the review deadline. For Active students, complete a Program Plan Change if AS Nursing is **not** your Active Program.
- 2. Submit all official non-FSCJ transcripts to the College when applying and prior to the review deadline date.
- 3. Have completed a minimum of 11 credit hours of prerequisites (which include BSC 2085C, BSC 2086C, MAC 1105 or higher level math) prior to the review deadline. A grade of "C" or better must be achieved in all courses. Complete a minimum of 19 credit hours of general education courses which include ENC 1101, MCB 2010C, DEP 2004, PSY 1012, 3 credit hours of State Humanities course, & State Civic Literacy course as required by your catalog year prior to admission to the professional phase of Nursing.
- 4. Have submitted current Health Education Systems, Inc. Admission Assessment (HESI A2/Elsevier A2 Preadmission Test) scores by the review deadline.

Applicants are expected to take a **complete** examination consisting of **9 sub-tests in one sitting prior to the review deadline**. Scores from the following 4 sub-tests are extracted for use in ranking. The 4 include:

- o Grammar
- Math
- o Reading Comprehension
- Vocabulary

A minimum score of 75% is required on **each** of the 4 above listed sections. Failure to achieve a minimum score on any of these 4 sections results in an automatic denial.

HESI A2 tests must be completed by the review deadline.

The webpage above will take you to the *Frequently Asked Questions* section. Please refer to the question, "How do I prepare for the HESI A2?" for recommendations on how to improve your scores. Please note, a short video clip is included.

- HESI A2 exams can be taken every 91 days with a maximum of 3 times in a twelve month period
- HESI A2 scores expire after 2 years
- HESI A2 exam retakes must include all 9 subtests

HESI A2 exams taken at any FSCJ Assessment & Certification Center will have results automatically recorded in the College database. Exams taken at any other location (not FSCJ), must have official score reports submitted to FSCJ. Paper score reports are not accepted. For information on how to have scores input, email north_testing@fscj.edu or call 904.713.6014. It is your responsibility to ensure your HESI scores are sent to FSCJ.
