

The Associate in Science (A.S.) in Medical Laboratory Technology

### **Program Requirements**

To meet the minimum requirements for consideration for acceptance to the Associate in Science Medical Laboratory Technology program, students must:

1. Complete an application for Florida State College at Jacksonville with Medical Laboratory Technology as the Program of Study.
2. Submit official non-FSCJ transcripts to the College prior to the review deadline.

### **Program Requirements**

#### Prerequisites

The following courses must be completed with a grade of C or better before the review deadline.

- CHM 1025C - Introduction to General Chemistry 4
  - or CHM 2045C - General Chemistry and Qualitative Analysis I 4
- ENC 1101 - English Composition I 3
  - or ENC 1101C - English Composition I Enhanced 4
- HSC 1531 - Medical Terminology (for Health Professions) 3
- MAC 1105 - College Algebra 3
  - or higher-level MAC prefix course
  - or MAP 2302 - Differential Equations 3
- MCB 2010C - Microbiology 4

#### General Education Requirements

Students must complete the following general education courses with a grade of “C” or higher before or during the professional phase of the Dental Hygiene program to fulfill the remaining general education requirements for the A.S. in Dental Hygiene.
