

# Chart Your Path to Success

## 1 Apply for Admission

- Visit [fscj.edu/apply](https://fscj.edu/apply) to complete your online application and pay your \$25 application fee.

## 2 Apply for Residency

- Log in to [my.fscj.edu](https://my.fscj.edu).
- Select the "Tasks" Tile, To Do's, Residency Declaration
- The residency declaration helps determine the tuition rate a student pays. A student who classifies as a Florida Resident will pay a lower tuition rate than the out-of-state rate.

## 3 Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and apply for Scholarships

- Visit [fafsa.gov](https://fafsa.gov) to access the online financial aid application. *FSCJ federal school code: 001484.*
- Apply for scholarships by visiting [fscj.edu/scholarships](https://fscj.edu/scholarships).

## 4 Request Your Transcript(s)

- Transcripts are required from all prior attended institutions, including high school. You are responsible for requesting your own transcripts. For a transcript to be considered official, it must come directly to FSCJ from the institution or the transcript vendor. We cannot accept copies from students directly.

## 5 Complete College Assessment

- Determine placement.
- Visit [fscj.edu/assessment](https://fscj.edu/assessment) to schedule your testing appointment.

\*\*SAT and ACT scores less than two years old may be used for placement.

\*\*\*Effective November 2013 under SB 1720, if you entered the ninth grade in a Florida public school in 2003 or after and graduated from a Florida public high school with a standard Florida high school diploma, OR if you are a student who is an active duty member of any branch of the U.S. Armed Services, you will not be required to take placement testing.

## 6 Register for Orientation

## 7 Complete First Term Advising

- Visit any campus Advising Center as a walk-in or schedule an academic advising appointment at [fscj.edu/advising](https://fscj.edu/advising).
- Download the **QLess app** to manage wait times on campus.

## 8 Register for Class/Pay for Tuition and Fees

- Enroll in classes online from your myFSCJ Student Center at [my.fscj.edu](https://my.fscj.edu).
- Also, pay your tuition and fees from your myFSCJ Student Center before the payment deadline.

## 9 Get Your Student ID Card/Parking Decal

- After you register for classes, visit the Library and Learning Commons to get your Student ID card.
- Visit [my.fscj.edu](https://my.fscj.edu) to request a parking decal. (Under **Useful Links**, select **Parking Decal/Registration**)

## 10 Download the FSCJ Safe Mobile App
