

Emergency Medical Services (A.S.)

Program Requirements

Application Procedure to meet the minimum requirements for consideration for acceptance to the Emergency Medical Services program, students must: 1. Complete an online Emergency Medical Services application by the application deadline.

2. Submit official non-FSCJ transcripts to the College prior to the application deadline date.

Additional Admissions Information

1. Preference is given to students who have successfully completed the college general education requirement for math.

2. Applicants must have an overall 2.0 GPA or higher.

3. Completion of BSC 2085C is recommended for students who plan to apply to the Emergency Medical Services program.

4. Admitted students must complete a Background and Drug Screening before admitting to the EMS program's professional phase.

COMPETITIVE REVIEW PROCESS

Students are ready for review by the admissions committee upon completion of all requirements above. The committee uses the Associate in Science in Emergency Medical Services Ranking Criteria below to review and rank candidates for admittance consideration.
