Purpose

The purpose of this procedure is to establish the authority over the security organization and standardized procedures for the safety and security of the College.

Procedure

- A. The Chief of Police, Director of Public Safety shall provide the appropriate number of security and police officers and services throughout the College for safety and security.
- B. The Chief of Police, Director of Public Safety shall develop and maintain Standard Operating Procedures (SOP's) for Security Officers to follow, as well as a written directive system following state statutes and the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) guidelines for police personnel. The procedures shall be reviewed annually and revised as needed.
- C. The Chief of Police, Director of Public Safety shall ensure security and police officers receive training in the Standard Operating Procedures and written directives pertaining to law enforcement.
