Purpose

The purpose of this procedure is to ensure compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, Florida Statutes, Florida Building Code and other applicable laws, codes, standards, rules and regulations.

Procedure

- A. New construction, renovation and remodeling projects are to be in full compliance with all applicable accessibility codes.
- B. The Associate Vice President of Facilities in conjunction with the College's Building Code Enforcement staff, is responsible to review design drawings and inspect projects during construction to ensure compliance with the current Florida Accessibility Code which is a stand-alone volume within the Florida Building Code.
