

- (1) The College President shall develop, or cause to be developed, procedures and requirements for the utilization of outside speakers or lecturers who appear at the College in classroom and non-classroom activities.
- Any individual, invited or uninvited, who disrupts the orderly operation of the educational institution, including the restriction of the free movement of students, employees, or visitors to the College who are on legitimate business at the College, shall be subject to the provisions of Board Rules, and may be subject to prosecution pursuant to applicable state laws and local ordinances.
