

As we continue to follow and monitor the daily impacts and updates of the Coronavirus, we want to assure all students, faculty and staff that we are taking all precautions and concerns in to consideration.

While the State University System has given the directive to universities to transition to online classes over the next three week period, this does not include state colleges in Florida. Based on information from the Florida Department of Education, the COVID-19 risk to students and employees at our State Colleges and K-12 institutions remains low. Therefore, FSCJ, along with the other state colleges in Florida, plans to remain open at this time.

We have taken several additional precautions which includes extra sterilization measures and suspending all student travel outside of our district (Duval and Nassau) through the end of March, with the exception of athletic competition.
