PROTOCOLS FOR CONTROLLING COVID-19

FSCJ MASK GUIDELINES

In response to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the FSCJ Emergency Management Team has implemented the following color-coded mask guidelines. The guidelines, based on current CDC recommendations, are intended to implement reasonable, research-based procedures, allowing for the face-to-face contact needed to satisfy course requirements and College operations. The guidelines may be adjusted as additional CDC recommendations are released. These procedures are consistent with CDC guidelines on how to protect yourself and others.

The FSCJ Emergency Management Team continues to monitor the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC) COVID-19 data to determine the following mask protocol.

LEVEL	Mask and Social Distancing Protocols
Red	Masks are expected in public, indoor settings.
Orange	Masks are recommended in public, indoor areas regardless of vaccination status.
Yellow	Masks are optional in public, indoor settings.

Wear Your Face Covering Correctly

- Wash your hands before putting on your face covering
- Put it over your nose and mouth and secure it under your chin
- Make sure you can breathe easily



We will communicate with you via Collegewide announcements when this protocol is changed and will continue to monitor conditions to determine when adjustments are needed to our protocols based on virus transmission in Duval and Nassau counties.
