In an abundance of caution, FSCJ will be extending spring break for students for one week, through Sunday, March 22. During this time, faculty and staff will be on campus to further sanitize all common areas and make plans to move toward a fully online learning environment. All FSCJ campuses and centers will be closed to anyone other than faculty and staff. If you have any questions or concerns, you can feel free to contact us through any of the methods below.

FSCJ is taking additional precautionary measures as students, faculty and staff return from Spring Break by requiring all who have traveled abroad since March 2 to self-isolate for 14 days from their date of return to the United States. This requirement applies to anyone who was required to use a passport to travel during this time period or who was on a cruise since March 2 (even if it did not make a foreign port of call). In addition, if you become symptomatic, you should not come to campus until you are cleared to do so by your physician and/or the health department. In order to not overwhelm our medical community and limit the spread of the virus, it is suggested that you look into telemedicine prior to arriving at any medical or healthcare facility.

FSCJ has also canceled all BlueWave athletic events through March 28 and suspended all FSCJ student sponsored travel outside of our service area (Duval and Nassau) through the end of March.

These preventive actions are essential to reduce the likelihood of exposure for those who are most at risk.
