NOTE: If you receive a positive test result, please do **not** come to campus. We value your confidentiality; at **no** time will your identity be shared as part of our contact tracing process.

 - Academic Advising and Financial Services will continue virtually but offices at Downtown Campus, Kent Campus, North Campus, South Campus and Deerwood Center will be open from 10 a.m.-2 p.m. on Monday-Thursday. In-person meetings will be scheduled on a case-by-case basis. <u>Make a virtual appointment</u>.
 - The Library and Learning Commons at Downtown Campus, South Campus, Deerwood Center and Nassau Center will be open with limited services, including ID badge creation, computer and internet assistance, library materials distribution and more starting on Monday, August 31.
