I understand that making future decisions can be a challenge right now. FSCJ wants you to know that your safety and the safety of your fellow students, faculty and staff drive all our choices.

Based on the best information we have about COVID-19 in our area and feedback from recent student and staff surveys, we've decided to move most courses online for the 2020 Fall Term. We will only offer classes that require in-person activities to maintain our expected high level of teaching and learning as face-to-face or hybrid courses. Any courses offered on campus will uphold appropriate social distancing guidelines, including the use of masks while on campus.

We are currently modifying the Fall Term schedule within myFSCJ to move classes online, as needed. If you registered for face-to-face or hybrid courses that will move to an online format, expect an email notification shortly.

Please note: If you initially registered for in-person courses that become online courses, you will not incur distance learning fees. However, after these courses move online, as early as July 6, new registrations will be charged the distance learning fee of \$15 per credit hour.
