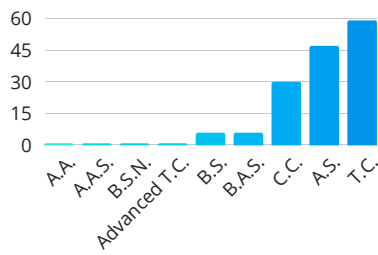

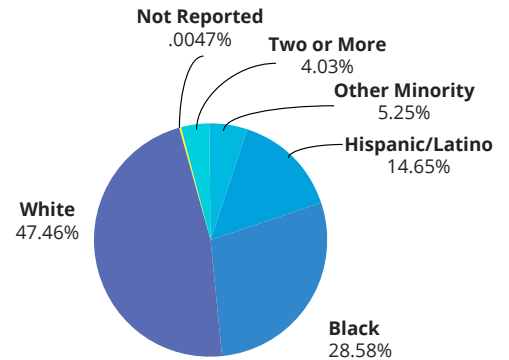

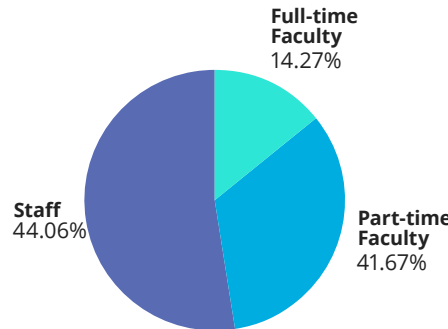

## NOTABLE HIGHLIGHTS

- FSCJ's Adult Education program was named the third-place winner of the 2020 Technology Commission Exemplary Practice Award for their "Using YouTube to Enhance the Student Experience" project by the Association of Florida Colleges Technology Commission.
- The Society for Human Resource Management (SHRM) awarded a 2019-20 Superior Merit Award designation to FSCJ's SHRM student chapter for providing superior growth and development opportunities to its student members.
- FSCJ was awarded a \$261,888 grant from the United States Department of Education for the TRiO Student Support Services (SSS) STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) program. The project is intended to provide

academic and other related support services for low-income, first-generation or disabled college students to increase retention and graduation rates, facilitate transfers from two-year to four-year colleges and universities, and to foster an institutional climate supportive of their success.

- The U.S. Department of State's Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs named FSCJ in the list of institutions that produced the highest numbers of Fulbright U.S. Scholars.
- FSCJ is home to an autonomous vehicle, the Olli, a fully electric, self-driving, 3D-printed shuttle which will help support several College programs that leverage the ADAS (Advanced Driver Assistance Systems) technology.
