PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Associate in Science (A.S.) in Business Administration is a versatile degree that provides students a comprehensive background to take them wherever they want to go in a business career. The program includes four technical certificates that can also be earned individually while completing the degree. At completion, graduates may begin a business career immediately or pursue a bachelor's degree in Business Administration, Supervision and Management or Financial Services for increased employment options and advancement opportunities.

Courses are offered fully online or as hybrid to accommodate students' schedules and learning preferences, with most courses also being offered in an accelerated eight-week format.

Mission/Purpose

The mission of this program is to educate, train and develop students to manage the ever-increasing complexities of business. Offering a balance between theory and practice, the program enhances the educational experiences and employment potential for students while also developing advanced business technical skills, administrative and management skills and critical skills in communications, quantitative and organizational understanding.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What are the program completion requirements?

To earn an A.S. in Business Administration, students must meet the following requirements:

1. Fulfill all academic requirements for the chosen program of study as outlined in the Florida State College at Jacksonville catalog and curriculum.
2. Earn a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 ("C") at Florida State College at Jacksonville in courses eligible toward the Associate in Science degree programs, excluding developmental education courses. (A.S. Florida State College at Jacksonville GPA).
3. Earn an all-college cumulative grade point average of 2.0 ("C") on a 4.0 scale on all courses attempted. This includes Florida State College at Jacksonville college-credit hours and transferred credits (excluding developmental education) in lower division courses. (All college cumulative.)
4. Complete a minimum of 25 percent of the total hours required for the program in residence at Florida State College at Jacksonville. Credit by examination and credit by portfolio development do not count toward this residency requirement.
5. Complete the required credit hours, as specified by the degree, of which a minimum of 15 credit hours must be General Education requirements.
6. Earn a grade of a "C" or better in each course used to satisfy the General Education requirements and any other area designated with a "C" or better requirement.
7. Fulfill all obligations, financial or otherwise, to the College before they may graduate.

Where are the educational courses held?

All courses required to earn the A.S. in Business Administration are offered at FSCJ Kent Campus, 3939 Roosevelt Blvd., 32205 and online. Many of the courses are also offered at Downtown Campus, North Campus, South Campus, Deerwood Center and Nassau Center.

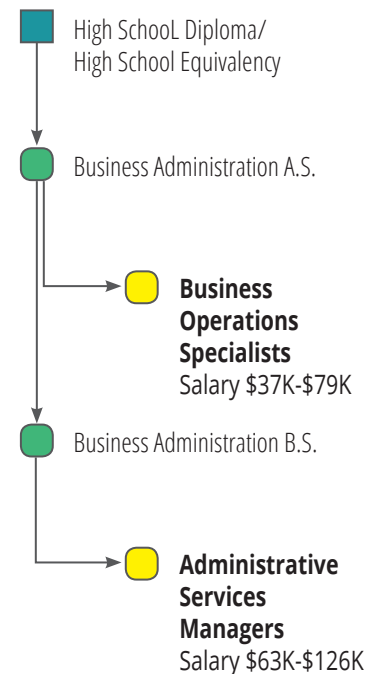

What is the cost of the program?

The approximate cost of tuition and fees is \$6,535.* Besides tuition and fees, students have to pay for things like living expenses, transportation, supplies and books. Book costs vary widely by program and course selection as well as choice of electives; students are encouraged to budget about \$80 per credit hour. Many students attending FSCJ qualify for financial aid, which can greatly reduce out-of-pocket expenses. This program is Federal financial aid eligible.
