### QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

1. Q: What is your budget?  
A: As the project is being funded through the State of Florida Department of Education from the Federal American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act of 2021, Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund – Deferred Maintenance Program. The Project Type: Environmental Deficiencies, Project Title: Building Envelope Upgrades and Study (roof replacement, curtain wall removal, replacement, re-roof) for multiple bldgs. The Grant College-wide allocation provision is \$13,730,406 to be utilized for multiple building envelope projects in which individual job projects fall under the "Project Type" and "Project Title" listed above. Currently, the College has engaged multiple projects at various College Campuses which complies with the Grant allocation provision, wherefore there is NOT a single job project budget.
  2. Q: We plan on bidding this with our roofing contractor, and they ran across something in the specs. The spec states 200-mile radius qualification in the spec for roofing. Is this true? They do work all over the east coast and FL their office is in Panama City, FL.  
A: As identified in Paragraph 1.00 of the ITB Submission documents, "The College is considering firms within a 200-mile radius of 501 W. State St., Jacksonville FL 32202 for service-related emergency repairs during the warranty period." Union prevailing wage rates are updated to reflect all rate changes in the collective bargaining agreement (CBA) governing this classification and rate.

#### Survey Rate Identifiers

Classifications listed under the "SU" identifier indicate that no one rate prevailed for this classification in the survey and the published rate is derived by computing a weighted average rate based on all the rates reported in the survey for that classification. As this weighted average rate includes all rates reported in the survey, it may include both union and non-union rates. Example: SULA2012-007 5/13/2014. SU indicates the rates are survey rates based on a weighted average calculation of rates and are not majority rates. LA indicates the State of Louisiana. 2012 is the year of survey on which these classifications and rates are based. The next number, 007 in the example, is an internal number used in producing the wage determination. 5/13/2014 indicates the survey completion date for the classifications and rates under that identifier.

Survey wage rates are not updated and remain in effect until a new survey is conducted.

#### Union Average Rate Identifiers

Classification(s) listed under the UAVG identifier indicate that no single majority rate prevailed for those classifications; however, 100% of the data reported for the classifications was union data. EXAMPLE: UAVG-OH-0010 08/29/2014. UAVG indicates that the rate is a weighted union average rate. OH indicates the state. The next number, 0010 in the example, is an internal number used in producing the wage determination. 08/29/2014 indicates the survey completion date for the classifications and rates under that identifier.

A UAVG rate will be updated once a year, usually in January of each year, to reflect a weighted average of the current negotiated/CBA rate of the union locals from which the rate is based.

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#### WAGE DETERMINATION APPEALS PROCESS

1.) Has there been an initial decision in the matter? This can be:

- \* an existing published wage determination
- \* a survey underlying a wage determination
- \* a Wage and Hour Division letter setting forth a position on a wage determination matter
- \* a conformance (additional classification and rate) ruling

On survey related matters, initial contact, including requests for summaries of surveys, should be with the Wage and Hour National Office because National Office has responsibility for the Davis-Bacon survey program. If the response from this initial contact is not satisfactory, then the process described

in 2.) and 3.) should be followed.

With regard to any other matter not yet ripe for the formal process described here, initial contact should be with the Branch of Construction Wage Determinations. Write to:

2.) If the answer to the question in 1.) is yes, then an interested party (those affected by the action) can request review and reconsideration from the Wage and Hour Administrator (See 29 CFR Part 1.8 and 29 CFR Part 7). Write to:

The request should be accompanied by a full statement of the interested party's position and by any information (wage payment data, project description, area practice material, etc.) that the requestor considers relevant to the issue.

3.) If the decision of the Administrator is not favorable, an interested party may appeal directly to the Administrative Review Board (formerly the Wage Appeals Board). Write to:
