Q1 Can you provide a better map of Cecil Center – South? We want to ensure we understand exactly which areas are included.

Q2 Who are the 2 incumbents? And what do they each maintain (which campuses)?

Chad Brock Enterprises, Inc. was a warded contract #2019C-17C Lots 1-5 & 7 for Grounds Care Maintenance & Landscape Services for Lot 1 (South Campus), Lot 2 (Deerwood Center), Lot 3 (Cecil Center), Lot 4 (Nassau Center), Lot 5 (North Campus) and Lot 7 (Kent Campus)

R&R Maintenance, Inc. (Currently Core Outdoors, Inc DBA/R&R Maintenance of Jax) was awarded contract #2019C-17R Lot 6 Downtown Campus for Grounds Care Maintenance & Landscape Services

Q3 How many flowers perrotation broken out by campus? (2x peryear – Spring and Fall)

Q4 How much mulch per location per rotation? (1xper year / 2" depth of Cypress Mulch)

Q5 How many Palms by location / by the 2 height categories?

Per Tree base on height. Please refer RFP solicitation document Sec 4.05 Gen Scope of Work – Palm Tree Trimming-letter N page 20.

Q6 Doesn't appear a Bond is required, but can you confirm?

Bond is not required in this proposal.

Q7 Irrigation is non-operational at most of the campus locations. How shall we bid irrigation checks if the irrigation is non-operational

Please refer RFP solicitation document Sec 4.05 Gen Scope of Work-Irrigation - letter G page 19.

Current operating status of the irrigation system varies by campus-center. Contractors should price work assuming irrigation system is operational. Efforts are underway to confirm irrigation is operational, requires repair and/or abandoned.

- Downtown Campus, Kent Campus, Cecil Center and Nassau Center are operational
- North Campus is operational at two ball fields, interior courtyard at main campus and along F building sidewalk. Balance of system was a bandoned including CJC.
- Deerwood Center is being made operational.
- South Campus is operational at M-buildings. Balance of system is not currently operational. Efforts are underway to restore operational use of the irrigation mains followed by quadrant zones.

Q8 Can you identify the location of the annual beds at each campus and if they have working irrigation for these beds

Please refer RFP solicitation document Sec 4.05 Gen Scope of Work—Flower/Ornamental Bed maintenance - letter F page 18. Annual beds vary by campus-center location. Routine watering of the annual beds will be maintained by FSCJ using hose bibs.


Q9 At Nassau center past the Driving track does it include the ORC center around the Buildings and equipment?


Grounds Maintenance should include rough cut of the ORC center 4 times yearly with a Z mower for suppression of fire, bugs and snakes at the ORC.
