Employee Engagement Survey

Last fall, HR partnered once again with North Carolina State University (NC State University) to initiate an Employee Engagement Survey. NC State University utilizes the Personal Assessment of the College Environment (PACE) online survey tool. We also conducted a separate part-time and adjunct survey. Both surveys provided an opportunity to understand faculty and staff perspectives while continuing a comprehensive view towards student success.

On March 22, an overview of the results of both employee engagement surveys was presented during OnPoint. Additionally, the survey results have been posted on the HR website to further ensure employees have access to the survey.

To access the page, visit fscj.edu/discover/humanresources, then click "Menu," select the "Resources" tab, then select "Employee Engagement Survey". You will need to log in with your FSCJ credentials. Next, select the 2022 folder under the PACE Surveys, there you will find an executive summary, an overview presentation of the survey results, and the PACE survey reports. As noted within the executive summary, the College's overall mean rating was 3.916. This decreased from 4.078 in 2020.

HR has heard you, and we are currently taking steps to address many of the concerns expressed by employees. We have shifted resources within the department to place a greater focus on improving employee engagement and retention and we are working through the goals outlined in the <u>VIP 2.0 strategic priority of Excellence (4.0)</u>. These efforts include enhancing our employee recognition program, creating a succession planning program, and developing a culture of operational excellence.

We look forward to partnering with our faculty and staff to further enhance employee engagement beyond the efforts that are currently underway. To that end, all employees are welcome to join us for our **Employee Engagement Survey Brown Bag Workshop on Thursday, April 6 at noon**. This discussion aims to dive deeper into the survey results and provide an opportunity for an open exchange of employee ideas on ways to further improve the climate at FSCJ. Register now.
