Insurance Identification Cards

Florida Blue

Florida Blue will generate health insurance ID cards as necessary. That may include new member cards and cards to members who changed plans during Open Enrollment. In addition, there are periodic updates to the magnetic strip on the back of member cards, which would necessitate the production of a new card. VSP Vision

Humana (Vision)

Humana will generate ID cards as necessary to include new employee cards and cards to employees who changed plans during Open Enrollment. Employees can access vision ID cards at <u>Humana Vision Care</u>.

Delta Dental

Delta Dental will generate ID cards as necessary to include new employee cards and cards to employees who changed plans during Open Enrollment. Dependent Insurance Premium Deductions

Full-time employees who have dependent coverage with the College's insurance plans (health, dental, vision) will see 2024 dependent premium rate deductions begin on their December 8, 2023 paycheck. FSA Fund Reminder

With the end of the 2023 calendar year and benefit plan year approaching, employees who are enrolled in a flexible spending account (FSA) with PayFlex are reminded account balances should be at or below the \$500 yearly limit that rolls over to the 2024 benefit plan year. From January through March 2024 rollover amounts can still be used to pay for medical expenses incurred during the 2023 calendar year. After March 2024, the rollover amount not used will be lost. Employees are not required to request leave (and supervisors should not approve absence requests submitted) for College Holidays or Winter Break. Employees who have leave requests previously submitted and approved for dates in which the College is closed for College Holidays or Winter Break should cancel those requests to prevent an impact on their absence balances.
