Updating Remote Worker Requests in myFSCJ

Telework and Remote Work Requests must be submitted by clicking the Remote Worker tile under Employee Self-Service in myFSCJ. Employees with a change to their flexible work schedule may contact benefits@fscj.edu for assistance with updating their Remote Worker Request. Additional information about flexible work arrangements is available on the <u>Telework website</u> and <u>APM 03-0802 - Telework</u>.

Verifying Your Work Location in myFSCJ

It is important for employees to verify their work location information in myFSCJ. This location is listed in the Microsoft Outlook Active Directory and has a direct impact on campus email distribution lists, and is also used to locate employees for emergency services and mail delivery.

Employees can view and update their Work Location by logging into <u>myFSCJ</u> and following the steps below:

- Select "Employee Self Service" from the drop-down menu. Click the "About Me" tile and then click the "My Location" tile.
- Click the arrow button under "Edit/View" to view your current Work Location.
- Select "Verify/Save" if the location information is correct.
- If the location information is incorrect, click "Add New", then enter the date and click "Continue" in order to select the Campus/ Building and Room Number.

Note: Use % as a search character. For example, if looking for room 101, enter %101% in the field. The system will return all instances where the number "101" is located in this field.

Remote Adjunct employees should select "Remote" as the location, and "Remote" as the room number. Should a room number not be available, contact <u>benefits@fscj.edu</u> to assist with adding a room number to the dropdown menu.

NEW Jacksonville Area Code

A new area code will soon be released in Jacksonville to accommodate the growing need of available phone numbers. In preparation for this release, a mandatory 10-digit dialing will be required whenever making local calls effective January 29. Learn more details about the new area code release <u>here</u>.

When calling numbers outside of FSCJ, 10-digit dialing is necessary. Employees are still able to simply dial the four-digit extension when dialing from one internal FSCJ number to another internal FSCJ number.

Professional Development Day Recap The 8th Annual Professional Development Day was held on Friday, January 5, at the Advanced Technology

Center. The day featured an outstanding Keynote speaker, Tony Bond from Great Places to Work, who spoke about creating and sustaining a thriving organizational culture that creates a fully human experience at work for all. He shared insight on the role of leadership and other key elements to move the culture needle. Over 175 employees attended his speech, and over 250 employees attended the 27 sessions offered throughout the day, with an average attendance of 25 per session. Survey feedback has been very positive. The 9th annual Professional Development Day will be held on Friday, January 3, 2025.

Math Conference Recap

The Math Conference was held at the South Campus Wilson Center on Thursday, January 26, and Friday, January 27. The Keynote was given by Dr. Julie Meer Phelps on the topic "Who's Doing the Thinking? Lessons Learned while implementing 'Business Thinking Classrooms.'" Dr. Phelps has been a professor of Mathematics at Valencia College in Orlando, Florida, since 1997. Twenty-six sessions were held, and more than 100 educators attended, including participants from surrounding school districts and colleges.
