## **Performance Reviews**

The rating step for Administrative, Professional, and Career performance reviews are now available in myIMPACT beginning May 1. The entire review process (ratings, review meeting, supervisor approval, and employee signature) should be completed no later than June 15.

As a part of the performance review process, supervisors must rate the Current SMART Goal(s) and add a Future SMART Goal(s). If an employee has a goal that spans multiple review cycles, the supervisor should give the appropriate rating that reflects the employee's progress toward the goal and then re-enter the goal as the employee's Future Goal so that the employee can continue working toward it.

## **Internal Job Search Notifications**

Human Resources is happy to announce the availability of the Job Search Agent notification feature in PeopleSoft. This feature aims to enhance internal employee advancement and career growth by providing notifications to employees when a new position is posted on the College's Career Page.

To set up Job Search Agent notifications, log into myFSCJ and follow the steps below:

- Select Employee Self Service from the top menu.
- Click the Careers & Recruiting tile.
- Click Careers.
- Click View All Jobs to retrieve all posted positions.
- Click Save Search and enter a search name.
- Check the "Email me when new jobs meet my criteria" box. The employee's College email address will be the default email address, but it can be changed to a personal email address.

As new positions are posted, the employee will receive an email with direct links to the job postings. If an employee only wants to be notified about particular positions, they can enter a specific job title, location, or keyword in the Search Jobs field prior to saving the Job Search Agent. Email notifications expire after 180 days, so employees will need to edit their Job Search Agent at that time to continue receiving notifications.

To view/edit a current Job Search Agent, log into myFSCJ and follow the steps below:

- Select Employee Self Service from the top menu.
- Click the Careers & Recruiting tile.
- Click Careers then select My Saved Searches. Employees can view the date the Job Search Agent expires.
- Click the edit (>) option to change the Search Name and email address or delete the Job Search Agent.

## Life Insurance Beneficiary Updates

Choosing beneficiaries and keeping those choices up-to-date is an important part of owning life insurance. All full-time employees have one-time their annual salary in life insurance provided by the College. The beneficiary designation for this and any supplemental life insurance is kept in myFSCJ.

To add/edit a beneficiary, log into <u>myFSCJ</u> and follow the steps below:

- Select the dropdown menu for Employee Self Service.
- Select the My Benefits tile.
- Select Dependents and Beneficiaries.
- Select Dependents and Beneficiaries Info.
- Select Add Individual or the name of the existing beneficiaries to edit.
- Select Save.

When updating beneficiary designation for life insurance, please review FSCJ beneficiary designation (final paycheck, leave payout, etc.), FRS retirement and/or any other additional savings plan beneficiary designations to ensure the most current information is on file.
