FSCJ campus stores at South Campus, North Campus and Downtown Campus will reopen on July 28—now powered by BibliU! This exciting change will bring a new look and feel to our campus bookstores, while ensuring that course materials are ready for students to purchase before the start of each term. FSCJ will continue to bring affordable, digital-first course materials through FSCJ's ACCESS program.

- Day-One Digital Access Students in FSCJ ACCESS classes will receive their required course materials automatically through Canvas, eliminating delays in getting textbooks.
- Significant Cost Savings FSCJ ACCESS ensures students pay the lowest possible price for course materials, usually far below traditional textbook costs.
- Financial Aid Compatibility FSCJ ACCESS charges are built into student tuition and can be covered by financial aid, making materials more accessible to all students.
- Opt-Out Flexibility In FSCJ ACCESS, students retain the ability to opt out and back in without penalty until the drop (add/drop) deadline.
- Faculty Insights With BibliU's platform, faculty can track student engagement data and monitor course material usage to help tailor instruction.
