Seeking Alumni Nominations for Anniversary Celebration



Faculty and Staff Accomplishments

FSCJ Professor of History Wesley Moody's book, "Hero of Fort Sumter: The Extraordinary Life of Robert Anderson," was recently published. Professor Moody is the author or editor of several books on the Civil War, including "Demon of the Lost Cause: Sherman" and "Civil War History."

About this book: As the commander of the U.S. garrison at Fort Sumter in the fateful early hours of April 12, 1861, Robert Anderson (1805-71) played a critical role in the unfolding of the Civil War. Although his leadership and his courage under fire catapulted him into national recognition, the attack on Fort Sumter was just one chapter in Anderson's story. That story, told here in full for the first time, offers a unique lens on the development of the U.S. military and the country itself before and during the Civil War.


