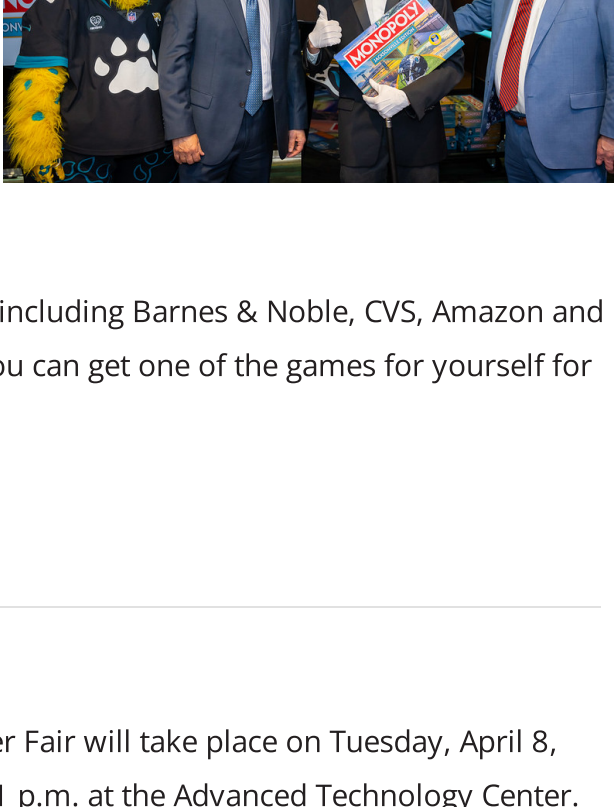

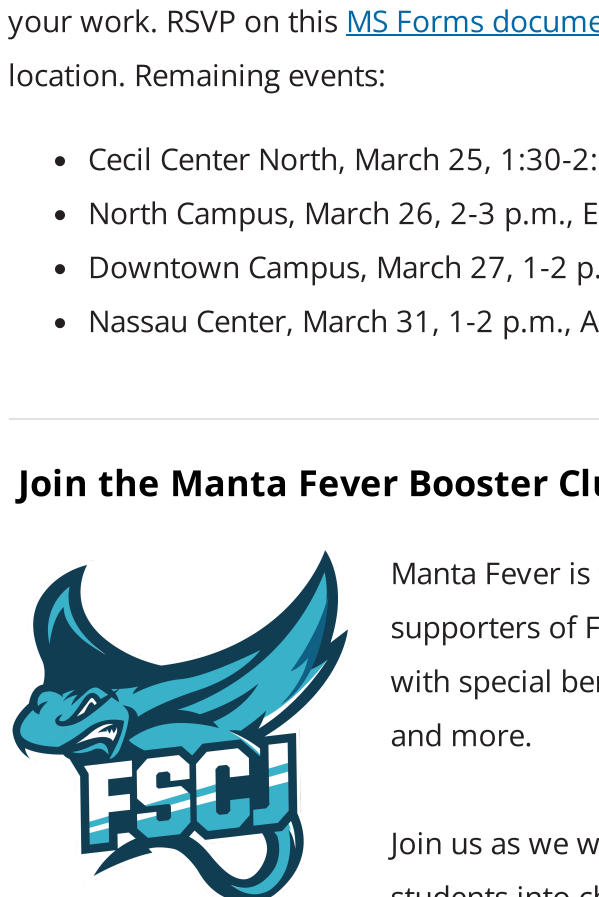

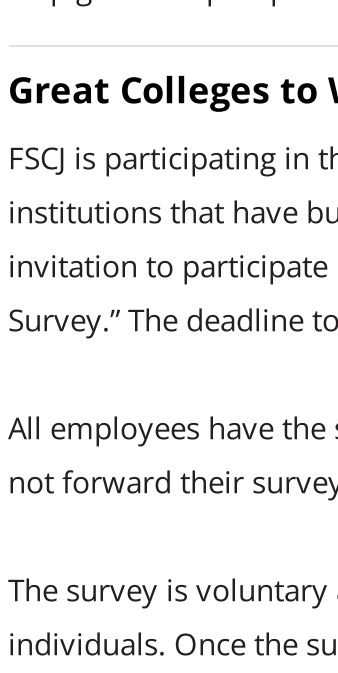
### Data in Motion: Insights on the Go

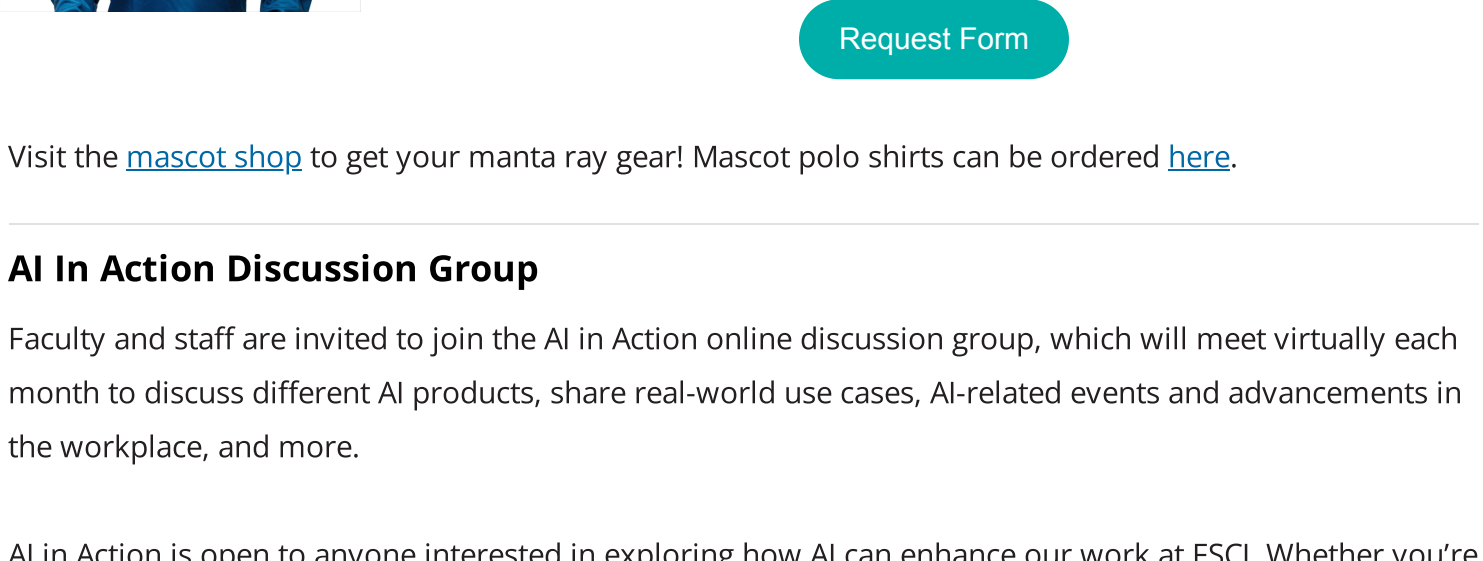

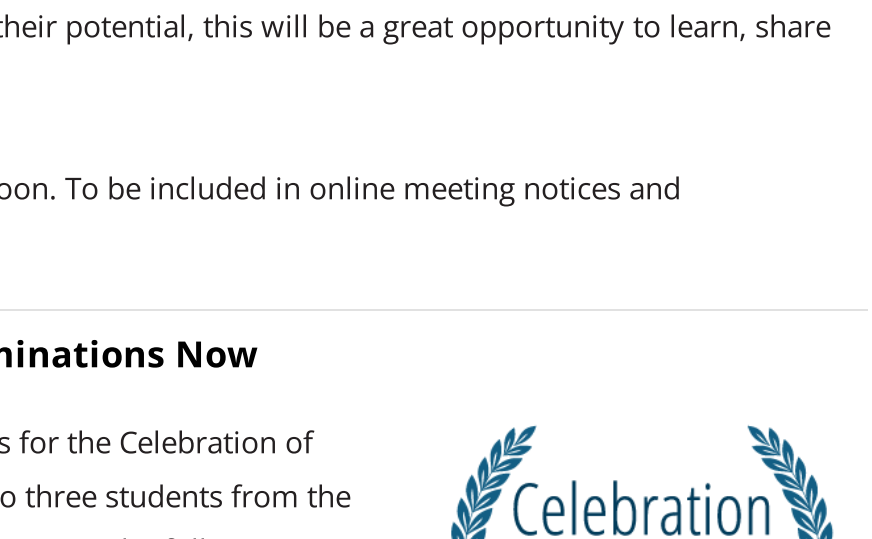

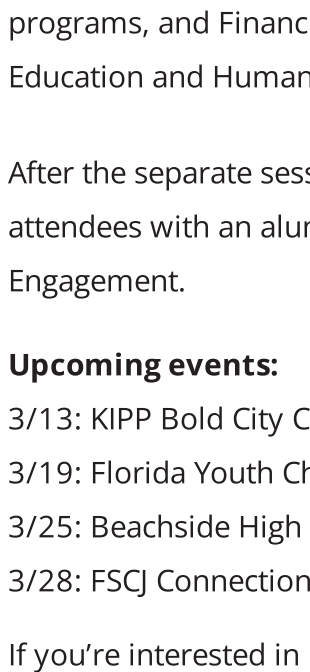

### AI In Action Discussion Group

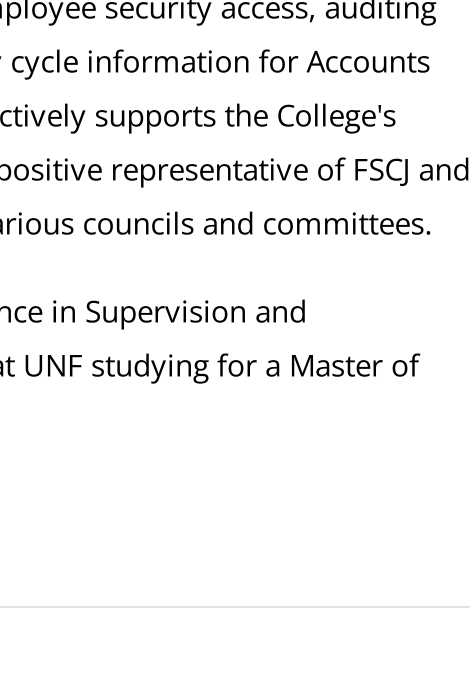

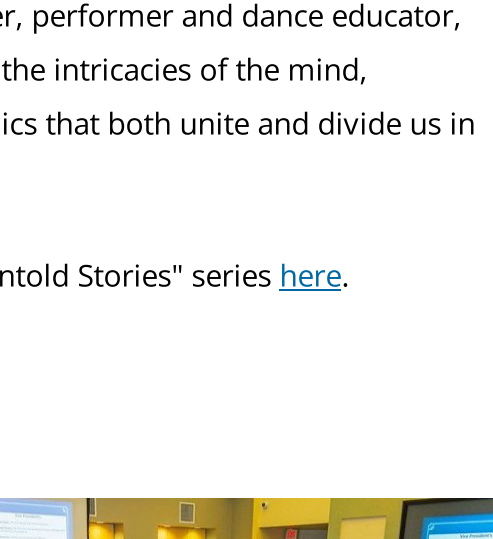
### Seeking Alumni Nominations for Anniversary Celebration

### Get to Know Your APC Colleagues: Paula Marshall



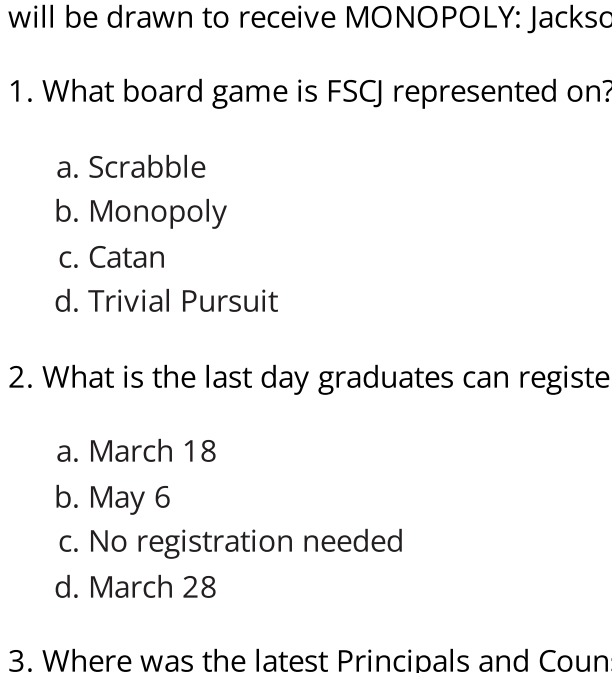

### Get to Know Your CEC Colleagues: Kaelin Guerrero



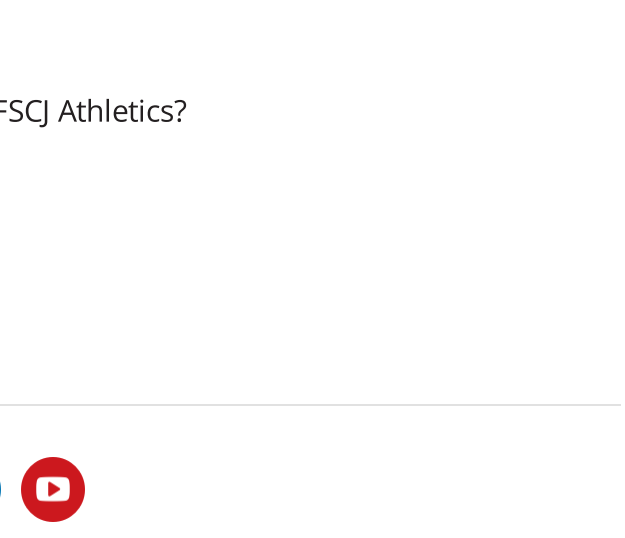


