#### **FSCJ Announces Memorial Scholarship** with PGA TOUR and THE PLAYERS Championship

On August 26, students at William M. Raines High School were the first to learn of the AJ Laguerre, Jr. Endowed Scholarship, a full scholarship established by the PGA TOUR and THE PLAYERS Championship to honor the memory of the Raines graduate who planned to come to FSCJ and major in cybersecurity.

During the announcement, Dr. Avendano posthumously awarded AJ an Honorary Associate in Science degree in Cybersecurity. The degree and a custom jersey were presented to family members in attendance.

## Military and Veteran Spotlight


