

## Nursing (A.S.) Program Roadmap

Use this roadmap to guide your progress and keep you moving toward graduation.

- Avoid surprises** – Meet with your advisor each term to monitor your progress and address concerns early.
- Review course requirements** – Check course prerequisites, corequisites, and conditions before registering each term to ensure you meet all requirements and stay on track for graduation.
- Stay eligible** – Maintain your GPA and complete required courses to remain in good standing.
- Graduate on time** – Stay on schedule to avoid delays and excess credit hours that may not be covered by financial aid.

### About the Program

**Credit Hours:** 72 total credit hours (including prerequisite coursework). Total hours may vary based on individual academic plan. Prior to enrolling in classes, please meet with an advisor for specific guidance about your individual academic plan.

### Application Procedure

**This is a Limited/Selective Access program.** Applicants who **complete all requirements by the published review deadline** will be considered for admission. Meeting the minimum requirements makes you eligible for consideration but **does not guarantee admission** to the program. See the program webpage for [additional admissions information](#).

To meet the minimum requirements for consideration for acceptance to the Associate in Science Degree Nursing program, students must:

- Submit a completed Florida State College at Jacksonville application and specify the Associate in Science in Nursing program as the desired interest area. Completed applications should be submitted by the published application deadline for the Nursing program.
- Submit official transcripts and official score reports.
- Complete a minimum of 11 credit hours of prerequisite coursework with a grade of C or higher prior to the application deadline for the Nursing program. A GPA of 2.0 must be maintained.
- Complete a minimum of 19 credit hours of prerequisite coursework with a grade of C or higher prior to admission to the Nursing program. A GPA of 2.0 must be maintained.
- Submit current Health Education Systems, Inc. Admission Assessment (HESI A2/ElsevierA2 Preadmission Test) scores by the application deadline. A complete administration is required and is made up of nine (9) sub-tests and must be completed in one sitting. Scores are taken from a single complete administration that is most advantageous to the applicant. Minimum scores of 75% are required for each of the following sub-tests: grammar, mathematics, reading comprehension and vocabulary. **Note:** Students are limited to three (3) attempts per year on the Health Education Systems, Inc. Admission Assessment (HESI A2/Elsevier A2 Preadmission Test).

### Review Deadline(s)

**May 15** for classes starting in the Fall Term, **September 15** for classes starting in the Spring Term, and **February 15** for classes starting in the Summer Term.

### Minimum Grade Requirement(s)

A minimum grade of C or higher is required in:

- All Prerequisite coursework
- All General Education coursework
- All Professional Nursing coursework

**Note:** Any student who does not earn a grade of C or higher in a NUR-prefix course will receive a grade of F or FN.

### Stay on Track

Meet the associate in science degree graduation requirements:

- Complete all academic requirements for this program outlined in the Florida State College at Jacksonville catalog and curriculum.
- Earn a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 (C) at Florida State College at Jacksonville in courses applicable to the Associate in Science degree programs, excluding developmental education courses.
- Earn an all-college cumulative grade point average of 2.0 (C) on a 4.0 scale on all courses attempted. This includes Florida State College at Jacksonville college-credit semester hours and transferred credits (excluding developmental education) in lower division courses.
- Complete at least 25 percent of the total hours required for the program in residence at Florida State College at Jacksonville. Credit by examination and credit for prior learning do not count toward this residency requirement.
- Complete the required semester hours for the degree, as including a minimum of 15 semester hours in General Education.
- Demonstrate competency in civic literacy by:
  - Completing a civic literacy course – AMH 2010, AMH 2020, or POS 2041 – with a grade of C or higher.
  - Achieving of the required standard score on a state-approved assessment.
- Earn a grade of a C or higher in each course used to satisfy the general education requirements and any other area designated as requiring a grade of C or higher.
- Satisfy all financial and other obligations to the College prior to graduation.
