

About the Program

The Advanced Technical Certificate (A.T.C.) in Paralegal Studies educates, trains, and develops students for careers as paralegals and legal assistants.

This program requires a **minimum of 22 credit hours**. Total program hours may vary based on the student's individual academic degree plan. This program **is not eligible** for financial aid.

Program Requirements

This is a Limited Access Program.

Students must follow the program application procedure and fulfill all requirements outlined in the college catalog.

Important for You to Know

This academic roadmap does not include advanced technical certificate graduation requirements.

Students in this certificate program **are not required** to complete math courses unless they are listed as part of the certificate program. Related programs suggest a **Mathematical Thinking in Context math pathway**. This pathway is intended for students whose academic program requires a foundation in descriptive statistics, probability, and inferential statistics to facilitate the use and interpretation of data.
