

About the Program

The Career Certificate (C.C.) in Facials Specialty provides a theoretical and practical hands-on approach to learning all aspects of facial specialty including facial treatments, sanitation/safety methods and procedures, facial makeup/ application, hair removal, and operation of skin care machines.

Note: If you are considering employment in a state other than Florida, please visit <u>fscj.edu/academics/license-disclose</u> to determine if this program will meet the selected state's educational requirements to sit for licensure or certification testing.

Classes are offered in the fall, spring and summer terms. Students may choose from a day or night program, the class hours are scheduled: Monday through Thursday, 9 a.m.-2 p.m. or 5 p.m.-10 p.m. at North and Kent campus.

Students are encouraged to review the Florida application requirements for facial specialist registration prior to applying to the Facials Specialty program. The application requirements are available on the Florida Department of Business & Professional Regulation website.

Related Career Pathways include the following Make-up Artist, Esthetician, Beauty Supplier, Image consultant, Lash Technician.

Related Industry Certifications: Upon completion of this program, students will be prepared for the following certification or license: Licensed Esthetician.

Program Requirements

This program is offered for full-time enrollment and requires 220 contact/clock hours that must be completed and documented. Students should also understand and accept the attendance requirements prior to enrolling in this career certificate program. This program is not eligible for financial aid.

Application Procedure

Students must complete the Career Certificate application to Florida State College at Jacksonville at <u>apply.fscj.edu</u>. Students may self-register when the Career Certificate application has been processed completely.

Catalog Year

This document is prepared for students with a 2025-26 College Catalog year. Students who enter under the 2025-26 catalog will be assigned to the degree or certificate requirements in effect during the 2025-26 academic year. The student's assigned catalog year will remain in effect as long as the student maintains continuous enrollment. Changes to requirements as mandated by law or by rule of the District Board of Trustees may supersede this provision.

To maintain continuous enrollment, a student must have registration for, and successful completion of, at least one course within a three-term period. After three consecutive terms of no enrollment, the student will be discontinued from the current program of study and will need to apply to FSCJ to reenter under the same program of study. Upon readmission, the student will be assigned to the current catalog of record in the chosen program.
