

## About the Program

The Career Certificate (C.C.) in Electricity (Construction) prepares students for a rewarding career in the all-encompassing electrical industry.

Students will attain the knowledge and skills needed for such career options as Maintenance Technician, Electrical/ Instrumentation Technician, Technician II - Power or Industrial Temperature Control/Management Trainee.

This program requires **1200 contact/clock hours** that must be completed and documented. Students should also understand and accept the attendance requirements prior to enrolling in this career certificate program. This program **is eligible** for financial aid.
