

# **About the Program**

The Career Certificate (C.C.) in Practical Nursing prepares students for employment in entry-level positions to provide direct care to clients in hospitals, nursing homes, clinics, and various health care settings under the direct supervision of a registered nurse or physician.

**Note:** If you are considering employment in a state other than Florida, please visit <a href="https://www.fscj.edu/academics/license-disclose">https://www.fscj.edu/academics/license-disclose</a> to determine if this program will meet the selected state's educational requirements to sit for licensure or certification testing.

This program requires **1350 contact/clock hours** that must be completed and documented. Students should also understand and accept the attendance requirements prior to enrolling in this career certificate program. This program **is eligible** for financial aid.

# **Program Requirements**

#### This is a Limited Access Program.

Students must follow the **application procedure** and fulfill the program requirements outlined in the College Catalog.

The **application deadlines are** May 15 for classes starting in the fall term, September 15 for classes starting in the spring term, and February 15 for classes starting in summer term.
