

Welding Technology Program Roadmap

Use this roadmap to guide your progress and keep you moving toward graduation.

- Avoid surprises** – Meet with your advisor each term to monitor your progress and address concerns early.
- Review course requirements** – Check course prerequisites, corequisites, and conditions before registering each term to ensure you meet all requirements and stay on track for graduation.
- Stay eligible** – Maintain your GPA and complete required courses to remain in good standing.
- Graduate on time** – Stay on schedule to avoid delays and excess credit hours that may not be covered by financial aid.

About the Program

Contact/Clock Hours: 1,050 hours that must be completed and documented. Students should understand and accept the attendance requirements prior to enrolling in this career certificate program. Prior to enrolling in classes, please meet with an advisor for specific guidance about your individual academic plan.

Full-time day program classes begin in the Fall Term and are held Monday through Thursday, 7 a.m.–4 p.m., for 8 months.

Part-time evening program classes are typically held Monday through Thursday, 5–9 p.m. (schedule subject to change) for 16 months. The curriculum for both programs is identical.

Related Career Options may include the following: LUA234 apprentice, ship yard welding, cutters, solderers, and brazers. The curriculum will prepare you to test T2, G2–G5 and with ceramic backing

Prior to enrolling in classes, students are strongly encouraged to attend a program information session to fully understand the career pathway. An academic advisor meeting is also suggested to develop an individual academic plan.

Minimum Grade Requirement(s)

- A minimum grade of C or higher must be achieved in all professional coursework.

Stay on Track

Meet the career certificate graduation requirements:

- Fulfill all academic requirements for the chosen program of study as outlined in the Florida State College at Jacksonville catalog and curriculum.
- Earn the required number of clock hours for the chosen program of study with a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 (C) on a 4.0 scale in all courses that apply to the chosen program of study.
- Complete a minimum of 25 percent of the total clock hours required for the certificate program as a student at Florida State College at Jacksonville.
- Fulfill all obligations, financial or otherwise, to the College before graduating.
- Meet or exceed the program's exit requirement(s), if applicable, or meet the criteria to earn a waiver.
