

Emergency Medical Technician Program Roadmap

Use this roadmap to guide your progress and keep you moving toward graduation.

- ☒ **Avoid surprises** – Meet with your advisor each term to monitor your progress and address concerns early.
- ☒ **Review course requirements** – Check course prerequisites, corequisites, and conditions before registering each term to ensure you meet all requirements and stay on track for graduation.
- ☒ **Stay eligible** – Maintain your GPA and complete required courses to remain in good standing.
- ☒ **Graduate on time** – Stay on schedule to avoid delays and excess credit hours that may not be covered by financial aid.

About the Program

Credit Hours: 12 total credit hours. Total hours may vary based on individual academic plan. Prior to enrolling in classes, please meet with an advisor for specific guidance about your individual academic plan.

The program follows a cohort-based model and students who are enrolled full-time may complete coursework within 15-weeks.

Application Procedure

This is a Limited/Selective Access program. Applicants who **complete all requirements by the published review deadline** will be considered for admission. Meeting the minimum requirements makes you eligible for consideration but **does not guarantee admission** to the program.

- ☐ Acceptance into the Emergency Medical Technician program is based upon academic performance and other criteria. A cohort is admitted each term. To be considered, individuals must complete the following by the appropriate application deadline:
- ☐ Complete an application for Florida State College at Jacksonville with Emergency Medical Technician as the Program Plan.
- ☐ Transcripts must be received from both high school/GED® and any postsecondary education. They must be official and sealed directly from the awarding institution. Transcripts may be delivered electronically to studentrecords@fscj.edu or by mail to: FSCJ Admissions Office, P.O. Box 40515, Jacksonville, FL 32203-0515.

These additional admission requirements are to be completed after acceptance into the EMT program:

- ☐ Submit to a criminal background check (national);
- ☐ Submit to a drug screening;
- ☐ Provide proof of a physical examination;
- ☐ Provide proof of immunizations (rubella, German measles, mumps, varicella, H1N1 virus, hepatitis B, tuberculosis, and flu shot).
- ☐ Provide proof of current driver's license;
- ☐ Provide proof of current personal injury protection (PIP) insurance coverage; and
- ☐ Provide proof of current health insurance coverage;
- ☐ Provide proof of current Basic Life Support provider (BLS) card (front and back). The approved providers are as follows:
 - American Heart Association (AHA) - Course Name: BLS Provider
 - American Red Cross (ARC) - Course Name: BLS/CPR for Health Care
 - American Safety and Health Institute (ASHI) - Course Name: Basic Life Support (BLS)
 - Military Training Network (MTN)- Course Name: BLS Provider

Note: Admissions preference is given to fully qualified candidates who have met all entrance criteria, including the satisfaction of prerequisite courses. Should seats remain available in the program cohort, applicants who fulfill admissions criteria prior to the start of the program will be considered next.

Application Deadline(s)

Day Cohort

- Fall Term deadline: May 15
- Spring Term deadline: September 15

Night Cohort

- Summer Term deadline: February 15

Minimum Grade Requirement(s)

- ☐ A minimum grade of C or higher must be achieved in all professional coursework.

Stay on Track

Meet the technical certificate graduation requirements:

- ☐ Fulfill all academic requirements for the chosen program of study as outlined in the Florida State College at Jacksonville catalog and curriculum.
- ☐ Earn minimum prescribed semester hours for the chosen program of study with a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 (C) on a 4.0 scale on all courses that apply to the chosen program of study.
- ☐ Complete a minimum of 25 percent of the total hours required for the program in residence at Florida State College at Jacksonville. Credit by examination and credit for prior learning do not count toward this residency requirement.
- ☐ Fulfill all obligations, financial or otherwise, to the College before graduating.
