

The Technical Certificate (T.C.) in Fire Officer Supervisor increases management skills for professionals employed as fire fighters.

This certificate prepares students for employment as firefighting and prevention supervisors to supervise fire fighters who control and extinguish fires, protect life and property, and conduct rescue efforts. The program is beneficial to professionals seeking career field enhancement.

**Note:** This program does not prepare students for certification as fire fighters and does not complete the requirements to be eligible to sit for Bureau of Fire Standards and Training (BFST) certification exams.
